



## **5-Panel vs. 10-Panel Drug Screening**

The **NON-DOT 5-panel** drug screen tests for the following substances:

1. OPI – Opiates
2. PCP - Phencyclidine
3. AMP – Amphetamines
4. COC – Cocaine
5. THC – Tetrahydrocannabinol

The **NON-DOT 10-panel** drug screen tests for the following substances:

1. OPI – Opiates
2. PCP - Phencyclidine
3. AMP – Amphetamines
4. COC – Cocaine
5. THC – Tetrahydrocannabinol
6. mAMP – Methamphetamines
7. BZO – Benzodiazepines
8. BAR – Barbiturates
9. MTD - Methadone
10. MDMA – Methylenedioxymethamphetamine

The **Federal/DOT Panel** is set by the US Government. As of January 1, 2018 it tests for:

- 1) THC - Tetrahydrocannabinol
- 2) COC – Cocaine
- 3) AMP – Amphetamine: Amphetamine, Methamphetamine, MDMA, MDA
- 4) OPI – Opiates: Codeine, Morphine, Heroin, Hydrocodone, Hydromorphone, Oxycodone, Oxymorphone
- 5) PCP – Phencyclidine
